

Organic Farming Training for Farmers Organized by Division of Agronomy, ICAR-IARI

The Division of Agronomy, ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI), New Delhi, organized during 7th October to 10th October, 2025. This training programme was for progressive farmers from Barmer and Jaipur districts of Rajasthan, focusing on organic farming practices.

On the inaugural day, the Dr. Ch.
